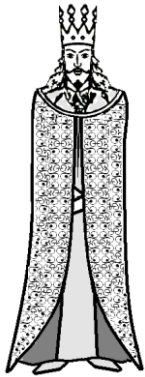

Find out what I am fond of.

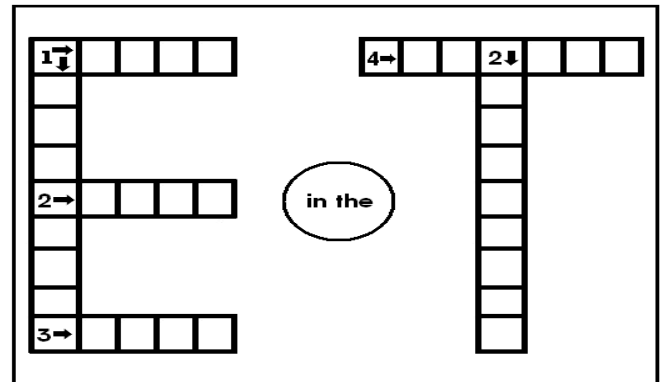
A. Do the crossword puzzle first.

#### 4. Hallo!(10 points)

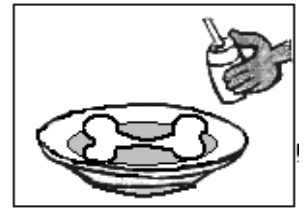
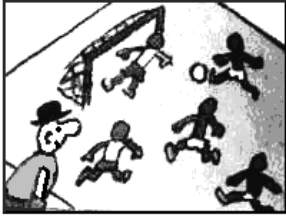
All people have to speak on the phone. Do you want to do it well? Let's have some practice!
